

Community Building Circles

1. Opening (How will you open this circle? A poem, quote, song, breathing, story, etc.)

Friday's Family Fair Flyer- Discuss the importance of this event and how it was an example of Service (R.I.S.E) since community members worked together for the benefit of one of their school groups.

2. Guidelines and Values (What questions will you ask to create shared guidelines & values?)

Review the shared guidelines and values.

3. Talking Piece (What objects are you using and why?)

The Flyer symbolizes community and working together for one cause.

4. Check In (How will you invite participants to describe how they are feeling?)

. Choose a color to describe how you are feeling today. (Display Emotion Color Wheel)

5. Discussion Round (What needs to be addressed in circle? What questions will you ask?)

Share a highlight of the family fair? What did you enjoy the most and why? How did it feel to come together to support the Music Department?

If students did not attend the fair, they can share a highlight of their weekend or any other event they have supported.

6. Check Out (How will you ask participants how they are feeling at the end of circle?)

Would you like to have another similar event? If so, what school cause /group can we support this time?

7. Closing (How will you close the circle?)

Chant, " R is for responsibility. I is for Integrity. S is for Service. E is for Empathy. Phoenix...We Rise!"
